GARDEN PROJECTS

We are in the process of doing some jobs for the Community Garden - labour only.

- 1. Garden Beds for the Disabled. Dave Ellis is constructing the raised garden beds and will ask for help when required. A hard surface will be put at the bottom of the ramp for easy wheelchair access paving, concrete or decking.
- **2. Shade Gazebo.** A shade gazebo is partly constructed on the arena and a fence is to be put up around it. We have a price to have the posts driven in 18 in total. It is up to the Gardeners to make a decision on the cost of this job.
- **3. B.B.Q. Gazebo**. The Garden is purchasing a 6m x 4.5m steel Gazebo in kit form for us to erect. We need to set it out and put in place 6 pads for the legs to bolt onto. We will have a plan soon so we can get started on the pads.
